José Antonio Salvarrey, 74, passed away on Saturday, May 27, 2017, in Roswell, New Mexico. Viewing will be Wednesday, May 31, 2017, 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM at Anderson Bethany Funeral Home Chapel.
