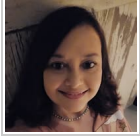

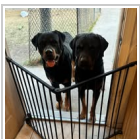

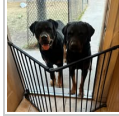

Don't be afraid to use my name.*

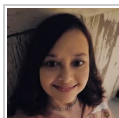
*Let your sorrow last for just a while.
