



## Juanita Campuzano

May 6, 1927 - September 17, 2013

A rosary will be recited for Juanita Campuzano, 86, of Hagerman NM at 7:00 pm Thursday, September 19, 2013, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Dexter NM. A funeral mass will be celebrated for Juanita at 7:00 pm Friday, September 20, at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church with Fr. Gonzalo Moreno officiating.

Juanita was born May 6, 1927 to Emiliano Barraza and Manuela Urbina in Valle de Zaragoza, Chihuahua Mexico. Juanita was a very strong woman, a fighter, never complained for any problem of any kind that life would throw at her. No matter what, she would have a smile on her face all the time. One of her memorable sayings was, "if you want something, you can achieve it, nothing is impossible." She was a devoted catholic, and was involved in fund raising and activities for her church. She had a special devotion for our Lady of Guadalupe, and created three large size master pieces of the virgin's image in crochet. Juanita's important things in life, was Family, she was the first organizer in the first family reunion in her home town, Camargo, Chihuahua, gathering over 100 relatives; including brothers, sisters, nephews, nieces, cousins, people that came from several cities within Mexico and the U.S.A. Some of her hobbies was crochet, she was creative in the kitchen and loved to come up with her own recipes. She never had to take time and make plans to travel, she was always ready to go back home to Mexico and visit family and friends. She loved to laugh out loud.
