Kenneth Roland Savage (USAF/Retired) will be missed by family and friends who knew him. There are no services planned at this time. He was 84 years young when he passed away at a local nursing home. Kenneth was born on July 28, 1925 in Minneapolis, MN to Edna and Wallace Savage. He became a career service man in 1942 by joining the Navy aboard the USS Ranger, and then joined the US Army Air Corp which later became the US Air Force. He was stationed at Walker Air Force Base in Roswell when he met and married his wife of 58 years, Hazel Miller. They were joined in marriage in Roswell before an adventurous life that took them to many places including Morocco, Africa. She survives him at home. Their first son, Kenneth Roland Savage, Jr. was born in 1952 in Roswell which became the first of 5 boys. In 1954, Steven Keith Savage was born as well as Dennis Ray Savage in 1956, David Bruce Savage in 1958, and the last boy, James Adrian Savage was born in Noussaur, Morocco, North Africa in 1961. They have 5 grandchildren; Christy, Heather, Kelle, Daryl, and Patrick and 11 great-grandchildren. Kenneth was an accomplished upholsterer and loved animals. He loved to travel and drive his motorhome. Some of the most enjoyable times were when he spent time in the mountains. He was a life member of the Curtis Montgomery Post 2575 VFW, Roswell Elks Lodge 969, retired members of the USS Ranger, and 509th Bombwing. He spent his life serving others and his country. Now he is free and out of pain, ready to drive a motorhome in the sky.
