A life-long resident of Roswell, New Mexico, Lewis Barr Neff, 71, passed away at his home on Monday, May 3, 2021.

On November 25, 1949, Lewis was born to Lewis Eugene Neff and Gertrude Charette Neff in Roswell, New Mexico, where he graduated from Goddard High School. He joined the United States Army and fought in Vietnam from 1970 to 1972. Lewis had an outstanding military career receiving several medals, including two bronze service stars and a combat infantryman badge. He proudly served his country until he was honorably discharged. Prior to retirement, Lewis worked as a postal carrier for thirty-three years. He will be missed by his family and friends.

Lewis was preceded in death by his parents, Lewis E. and Gertrude Charette Neff.

In line with Lewis's wishes, a private graveside service was held on Wednesday, May 19, 2021, at South Park Cemetery.
