She always made sure they knew there was a safe place for them as they grew up. At times, Lily took a few of them in and gave them a place to stay when they needed. When they all grew up and began their own families, she sought out her next adventure. She reached out for the opinion of her daughter and son-in-law, whom both encouraged her to take the position as a tutor at a local literacy organization. Lily began there as an ESL tutor, helping people with reading, writing, and math. She had the pleasure of meeting many different people, with many different needs. Her students meant a lot to her, and she helped them in any way she could. Lily later became the office assistant, where she developed a special friendship with some of the directors and tutors, including Dore Luna-Gonzales, Jan Murrow-Bostic, Melissa Urban-Cobos, and John

Grogan.
