Linda lost her long, hard-fought battle with cancer on August 30, 2014 in Santa Fe, NM. In 1974 she married Gary Hernes, and they moved to Santa Fe, NM with their daughter, Shauna.

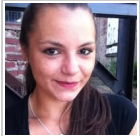

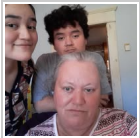
