Linda was born on June 3, 1945, to Windrell (Cicero) Hughes and Lura M Hughes in Carlsbad, NM. Her family moved to Roswell, NM when Linda was in the 7th grade. She then attended and graduated from Roswell High School. It was in high school that she met what would become the love of her life, Bobby Holley. She loved to tell the story of how their love story began. She would say this good-looking guy came up to me in the hallway and said, "when my girlfriend moves, I'm dating you". They began dating soon after and were married on October 20, 1964, in Carlsbad, NM. Becoming a Navy wife, they briefly lived in Texas and Rhode Island until Bob was discharged from the Navy. The two settled back in New Mexico and eventually found their way back to the Roswell/Artesia area to raise their boys. Linda worked in insurance for some time in both Roswell and Artesia, but it was at home that

she found herself with one of the most underrated yet difficult jobs you could have. She was a police officer' wife. If that alone wasn't stress enough, both of her sons and a grandson became police officers as well. For 40 plus years, the worry she must have felt as she wanted to make sure "her boys" were safe. Linda and Bob were blessed with 61 wonderful years together. She loved watching her Dallas Cowboys and going to the horseraces in Ruidoso. Most importantly, she was a Christian.
