Linda was born June 21st, 1978, in Hobbs, NM to Steve (now deceased) and Jane Mondy, where she spent the first few weeks of her life until her family moved back to Roswell. She was an adorable baby and a sweet little girl. She loved spending time with her grandparents. She especially loved going to Furr's Cafeteria with her grandma and doesn't every child need a grandma to teach them to play poker. Linda attended Monterrey, Mt View and Roswell High School; she was in gifted. She was Freshman and Sophomore class president and on yearbook staff.

At 18 she married Anthony and became mother to a precious 3-year-old, Ivy. The marriage only lasted a few years, but we kept Ivy in the family. Linda and Ivy loved each other dearly, Ivy was her sweet pea. Later she married Fernando, they lived in Albuquerque, then Vegas, then back to Roswell. She also spent 6 months living in Las Cruces. Eventually they went their separate ways. Over the years Linda worked at Tabosa, Golden Corral, TCBY, Baskin Robbins and Red Lobster in Roswell, Albuquerque and Las Vegas.

Linda always had a soft spot in her heart for people and animals in need. She brought home strays starting as a child. As an adult she worked with the homeless and mentally disabled. She volunteered and served on committees and won an award in Santa Fe.

Linda also faced many health issues. At 11 she fell at the skating rink, broke her hip and was bedridden in a spica cast for 3 months, no more softball for her. That was the beginning. Nine years ago, she was hospitalized and almost died with something called DRESS syndrome. It took a lasting toll on her mind and body. She voiced her frustration at times. Mostly she kept smiling.

She'd found love. She cherished the time she spent with her grandchildren. She enjoyed living in the country with all her animals. She looked good, that's why her passing caught us so off guard. Her struggles are over, rich blessings are in store, she is a child of God. Linda will be missed.
