She graduated from Hatch High School in 1977 and worked as an ESL/GED Teacher for Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell for many years. Lorenza had a passion for teaching. She knew from an early age that teaching was her destiny. Lorenza worked at Job Corps as a math teacher from 2010-2012 and as a teacher's aide at Washington Avenue Elementary School from 2013-2014. In 2014, She found one of her greatest callings: teaching fourth grade at El Capitan Elementary with her fellow dream teamer Rubi Rascon and Kathy Blount. Lorenza loved all her students and would call them "My Millions."

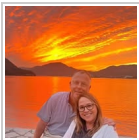
