Obituary for Luzmila Tarin

A rosary will be recited for Luzmila Tarin, 48, of Roswell at 7 pm Sunday, Dec. 30, 2007, at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church. A funeral mass will be celebrated at 12 noon Monday, Dec. 31, 2007, at St. John's with Father Juan Montoya O.F.M. officiating. Burial will follow in South Park Cemetery. Luzmila passed away Friday, Dec. 28, 2007, at her home surrounded by the love of her family.

Visitation for Luzmila will be from 10 am to 5 pm Sunday at the funeral home and from 5:30 to 9 pm at St. John's. The family will receive friends at a reception following the burial at the Ave Maria Center 401 E. Bland.

Luzmila was born on March 24, 1959 to Pedro Tarin and Carlota Gomez Tarin in Ojinaga, Mexico. She moved to Roswell as a little girl in 1962. 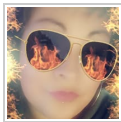
