Lydia Martha Guajaca-Saiz was born on December 14, 1964, and at 10:32 pm October 9, 2016, Heavens Gates opened wide to welcome her home. Lydia's prayers have been answered as God has healed her heart, body, and soul. She is walking on the Streets of Gold in Heaven alongside her mama and daddy.

Lydia was born in Roswell, NM, to Elias D. and Patricia Hernandez Guajaca. She attended school in Roswell and graduated in 1983, from Roswell High School. Lydia successfully obtained her Bachelor's Degree in Sociology/Criminal Justice from Eastern NM University in 1990. Since that time, Lydia has dedicated her professional career to child counseling at Counseling Associates, Chaves County Youth Services, CASA, Family Pride, Roswell Job Corps, and most recently at Wings for Life.

Lydia was married to Rosendo Saiz on September 11, 2004, in Roswell. While Lydia never had any children of her own, she was "Nina" to many. She loved all her nieces and nephews dearly and cared for each one of them as her own. Lydia attended St John's Catholic Church her entire lifetime. She dedicated many years to teaching Confirmation classes. She loved God. Lydia's dedication to her faith never wavered. Lydia was involved with other community projects over the years. As a child counselor, she worked very hard to help many young teenagers and children. She was a strong advocate

of Tessa Anderson's Suicide Prevention Project and Wings for Life. Lydia's hands touched and saved many lives.

Lydia is survived by her three sisters: Miquela Rue (Manuel), Frances Lucero (Bob), and Pat Kuemmerle (Tom). Her three brothers: Richard Guajaca, Freddie Guajaca, and Anthony Guajaca (Yvonne). Mother-in-laws: Juana Saiz and Judy & Jr Spangler. 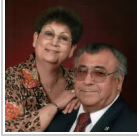

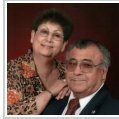
