Manuel passed away on Sunday, April 14, 2013 at his home.

Manuel was born December 29, 1937 to George and Aurora Archuleta in Roswell, NM.

He will be forever grateful for the love and friendship shared with the mother of his children.

Manuel served in the United States Navy on the USS Kidd as a deck hand stationed out of San Diego, California from January 31, 1956 - January 30, 1962. He worked for Auto Supply, Denios, Pepsi Cola Co., Car Quest, and finally Roswell Ford as a parts specialist for twenty years.
