January 16, 1925 - July 19, 2020

MARCELINO V CAMPOS died peacefully on Sunday, July 19, 2020, at 95 years of age. He was born on January 16, 1925, in Grandfalls, Texas, to Marcelo and Gregoria (Valencia) Campos.

Marcelino served in the US Army and received the World War II Victory Medal and the Asiatic Pacific Theater Ribbon. After discharge from the Army, he returned home and married his sweetheart Rosie (Rosa) Otero, on August 3, 1947. They were married for 70 years. Marcelino was a mechanic and truck driver for Holsum Baking Company for many years, with routes to El Paso, Carlsbad, Las Cruces, as well as Clovis and Fort Sumner. He was excited to tell family and friends that he had had the opportunity to pull the longest trailer in New Mexico. Later, Marcelino went on to work for Ray Bell Oil Company until his health began to fail. He enjoyed visiting and joking with family, friends, customers, and children alike so much that one day a neighborhood child knocked on our door and asked if 'Mr. Campos could come out and play.' He will be missed by many.
