I will never forget the story she related of the time she was on patrol and got the call that a child had fallen in an irrigation ditch. She was the first responder and on arrival removed her hat, weapon, Sam Brown belt and boots and was about to jump into the water when the Department Scuba Team arrived and yelled for her to spare her uniform, they would get the child. She watched them jump into the water and reach the child who was standing on a large rock.....and then remembered she didn't know how to swim. Her concern for the child overruled her fear of the water.

She faced cancer with the same fearlessness and lived almost seven years after the doctors had given her three months.
