On October 10, 1954, Max was born to Pablo Romero and Teresa Romero in Santa Rosa, NM. He attended Roswell High School, where he graduated early in 1972.

He enlisted in the United States Army, Company D, First Battalion and Fourth Advanced Individual Training Brigade clerk course. He was a trainee in the Leader Preparation Program; Sixth US Army officer and NCO M-42 school. During the time he was serving his country, he was awarded the National Guard Bureau Guardsman Award in the Minute Men Project in Camp Grayling, Michigan; US Army National Safety Council's Defensive Driving Campaign (Multiple Vehicles) of Fort Ord, California. He was honorably discharged from the United States Army National Guard on July 30, 1979, as a Sergeant.

He married Cecilia Y. Romero on July 6, 1974, in Roswell, NM.

He was involved in many volunteer activities such as the Patriot Guard Services and Missions Christmas Drive. He was an active member of the Kiwanis Club of Roswell since March of 1989. He was involved with the Salvation Army Holiday Donation Charity.

Max was a family man, and he enjoyed spending time with the family on their vacations. His hobbies were restoring classic muscle cars and going to car shows with the family, attending and instructing sales seminars, traveling, fishing, computer software programs, riding, working and detailing motorcycles. He would frequently watch YouTube videos in his senior years. He loved playing racquetball, softball, basketball, and baseball with the neighborhood kids.
