Miguel, age 93, passed away Tuesday, October 4, 2011 in Roswell.

Miguel was born September 29, 1918 in Ancho, NM to Cruz and Theodorita (Montoya) Otero. He married Barbara Garcia on April 21, 1947. Miguel served in the US Army in the 1080th Quartermasters Company Air Service Group which included the Burma-India Campaign from 1942-1946. Miguel had the honor and privilege to supply the Merrills Marauders with supplies they needed to help them defeat the Japanese in Burma.
