Mike "Pic" Croney, 96, of Roswell peacefully went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus, at his daughter's home on Thursday, July 5, 2012. A private family memorial will be held at a later date.

Born the sixth of seven children in Glenco, WY to Tom and Julia (Radomski) Croney. He was preceded in death by his parents and siblings.

He then went to work for the Union Pacific Coal Co. on the loading tippie before working underground in the coal mine. After the coal mines shut down in 1953 he went to work for Hanna Nickel Smelter in Riddle, OR as maintenance and welder. The family returned to WY in 1962 where Mike worked for U.S. Steel Co. near Lander, WY, until retiring in 1978. In 1980 Mike and Gert moved to Roswell, NM to be near their son and family – escaping the cold Wyoming winters.

His greatest pleasure was camping and fishing with his precious family in the Upper Green River, WY, Sage chicken hunting in the Upper Sweetwater, WY

and camping in southern Colorado.

He was an adoring and devoted husband, father and grandfather and will be greatly missed.
