Obituary for Nancy Edith Schale Wilson

Memorial services will be held at 2:00 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 15, 2007, at Anderson-Bethany Funeral Home for Nancy Edith Schale Wilson, a twenty-one year resident of Roswell, New Mexico, who passed away in Roswell on November 11, 2007.

Mrs. Wilson was born April 30, 1930 in El Paso, Texas where she grew up, graduating from Austin High School in 1948. Mrs. Wilson married Eugene Kennon Wilson, also of El Paso, on August 5, 1949. Much of her married life, 1951 to 1986, was spent with her husband and family as part of the El Paso Natural Gas Company and involved living in Arizona, New Mexico, and Texas along the company's expansive pipeline system. One assignment, however, from 1978 to 1980, was in Oran, Algeria, where her husband worked in the company's international natural gas liquefaction project.

Upon her husband's retirement, Mrs. Wilson and her husband, Gene, settled in Roswell where they have lived since 1986.

Mrs. Wilson was devoted to her husband and family, and she enjoyed travel, golf, tennis, and gardening. Mrs. Wilson also enjoyed arts and crafts, and leaves her extended family many heirloom afghans that keep the family warm around the world.

Mrs. Wilson was preceded in death by her father, Albert Arthur Schale of Hillsboro, New Mexico, and her mother, Edith Evangeline Shaw Schale of Trinidad, Colorado. She is survived by her sister, Alberta Lou Schale Warner

of Fort Worth, Texas, and her brother, William Frank Schale of Dallas, Texas. Mrs. Wilson is also survived by her loving and devoted husband of fifty-eight years, Gene; three sons, Eugene; three sons, Eugene Kennon Wilson, Jr., of Springfield, Virginia, Warren David Wilson of Farmington, New Mexico, Patrick Shawn Wilson of Canyon, Texas; one daughter, Virginia Christine Wilson Heronimus of Hickory, North Carolina; ten grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.
