Nieves Ramey, 77, passed away peacefully on Friday, April 6, 2018. There will be a Viewing at Anderson Bethany Funeral Home on Tuesday, April 10, 2018, from 1:00 PM - 7:00 PM. On December 5, 1940, Nieves was born in Tornillo, TX, to Gomesindo and Elizabeth Silva. Both her parents preceded her in death. Nieves married her Airforce man, Otis Don Ramey on May 31, 1960, in Roswell, NM. They moved to Denison, TX, where they lived on base. Then on March 14, 1961, Gregory Don Ramey was born, and he was the light of her life. Greg was her pride and joy and she made sure that she was the best mom to him. They moved to Garland, TX, after Don returned from a tour in Alaska. She moved to Grapevine, TX, where she managed Dons Restaurant La Casa. This is where she got to meet players from her favorite football team, the Dallas Cowboys. Every Thursday at the restaurant there was a

radio show that was MC'd by her friend, Troy Aikman. She also became good friends with some other players, such as Harvey Martin and Drew Pearson, from the Cowboys. Meeting Roger Staubach and Tom Landry were some of the highlights of her life. She sure loved her Dallas Cowboys and was a proud fan. In 1998, she fell ill and decided to move back home to Roswell. She lived with her son, Greg, her sister, Faye who was her right-hand man and brother, Eppie on the Silva ranch. She worked for Dr. Haney, who became more like family than an employer. She was a social butterfly so when it came to helping with parties and get-togethers, she was the one to talk to. Nieves was also a proud life member of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars. One of her favorite things about being back in Roswell was getting her family together.

A sassy, funny and loving mom, sister and aunt, Nieves loved life and lived it to the fullest. Her strong will and positive outlook on life were what kept her going every day. She had a heart of gold and would be there for anyone that needed her. Nieves favorite past time was going to the casino in Ruidoso or what she called "the hill," with her family so she could play those slot machines. She had a love for Elvis Presley music and would share it with Greg. Nieves always looked forward to the girl's trips with her wonderful friends Sharon Thomlinson, Patty MaGourick, Judi Bishop, and Jerie Walters. She also loved OD (Ponch) Walters, Jerie's son, who she would babysit when Greg was a baby. She also loved spending time with her friend, Lynn Rivas. One of her other favorite things was going to golf tournaments and supporting her friend, Nancy Lopez and spending time with her friend, Melba Lopez. Nieves had to attend dialysis every week and you would think that she would be miserable having to do this, but she lived a happy life and let nothing stand in the way. The staff and patients at dialysis loved her as a patient because of the goodies that she took every week. She would talk to everyone and put a smile on their face if they were having a bad day.
