Orville Grady Freeman, 74, passed away on March 2, 2015 in Hagerman, NM. He was born on May 29, 1940 to parents Horice Freeman and I.V. Raper in Tucumcari, NM.

Orville served on the Hagerman Volunteer Fire Department for 57 years and was a Volunteer EMT for 18 years. During that time, he worked 11 years for the Chaves County Sheriff's Department and 5 years with the Hagerman Police Department before becoming the Director of Public Works for the City of Hagerman.

His passions were woodworking, fabricating-metal working, welding, and was a part of Freeman and Son Blacksmithing with his Father for 4 years.
