During World War II, he served with the United States Army. He served in the Philippines, surviving the Bataan Death March and three years as a POW in a Japanese Prison Camp. Avery was a 32nd Degree Mason and a Scottish Rites Shriner for fifty-six years. He lived in the Artesia area most of his life, where he owned, or was employed by, several auto dealerships. Avery is survived by Nina Elizabeth Boggs, whom he married in 1945, six children, Wesley and Barbara Cox of Lubbock, TX, W. A. "Bill" and Alison Cox of Albuquerque, NM, Elizabeth "Kay" Ross of Roswell, Oscar "Bert" and Delene Cox of Albuquerque, Larry And Renae Cox of Midway, and Glyna and David Mullins of Artesia; and numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and one great great-grandchild. Avery was preceded in death by his parents, Jack and Almeda Cox and an infant son, Lesley.
