Pablo Romero, 82, of Roswell passed away Sunday, August 28, 2011 at his home surrounded by his family. Pablo was born May 20, 1929 to Jose Getrudes Romero and Agueda R. Romero in San Ignacio, NM. He served as a member of the US Armed Forces-Army Corps of Engineers and was Honorably Discharged in 1952. He married Teresa Flores while stationed in Camp Carson Colorado.
