I would visit my Mother in Roswell every year for 40 years and Paul would always have some out of the way interesting places to visit. I will never forget the places we visited, from Yellowstone, to Top of the World in Cody, Wyoming where very few made it to the top of Beartooth Pass. We did! Remember the Moose that chased Sookie, and the Grizzly that tore up our campsite. So many places and locations, which always turned into intense physical, and sometimes dangerous bushes with nature.
