Services are scheduled for Paul Hutsell, 81, of Roswell on Thursday, March 24, 2011, 2:00 pm, at First Assembly of God Church in Roswell, with Rev. Phil Hutsell officiating. Burial will follow at South Park Cemetery. The family will be receiving friends and condolences at the funeral home with a public visitation on Tuesday, March 22, 2011, 6:00 pm-8:00 pm, and again on Wednesday, March 23, 2011, 6:00 pm-8:00 pm.
