Paul Edward Johnson was born February 17, 1933, the son of Grant and Helene Johnson in Morris, Illinois. He was baptized on March 26, 1933, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Morris, IL, and confirmed June 1947, at St. Olaf Lutheran Church in Aurora, IL.

Paul graduated from both Carthage College, Carthage, IL, in 1955, and Luther Seminary, St. Paul, MN, in 1959. He was ordained as a Lutheran pastor on June 7, 1959. He subsequently served as a pastor at Lutheran churches in Southern and Central California, Las Vegas, NV, and as an interim pastor at St Mark's Lutheran Church in Roswell, NM.

Paul was married to Judith Lee Meyer Johnson on June 23, 1956. He spent his life serving others and sharing the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. On Sunday, February 11, 2018, Paul was transferred to the Church Triumphant at the age of 84 years.

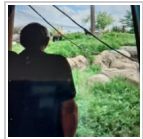
