Randy was born April 17, 1955 in Grant, Nebraska to Jacob and Ruth Seiler. His father and step father, Albert Bushkovski, preceded him in death. Randy is a 1973 graduate of North Denver High School, attended Colorado NW Community College in Rangeley, CO, and earned his Bachelors Degree in 1977 and Masters Degree in 1982 from Adams State College in Alamosa, CO.
