On August 23, 1947, Richard was born to Tito and Lucy Anglada in Taos, New Mexico. After graduation, Richard joined the United States Army; during his service, he received several awards, including a Bronze Star, an Air Metal, and a Purple Heart. He married the love of his life, Marianne, on March 25, 1969, in Alamosa, Colorado. Richard and Marianne were members of the Assumption Catholic Church Parish. He was involved in many volunteer activities, including Chaves County Veterans and First Tee Golf Program, and was a coach for Little League baseball; he was also a Past Exalted Ruler for the Elks Lodge 969; he volunteered for many charities, including Elks for Vets and Elks for Wounded Warriors. Upon retirement from the United States Postal Service, Richard spent many days doing things he loved, including golfing, traveling, and spending time with his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren; they truly were the lights of his life.
