A Memorial Mass for Richard J. McGrath, 80, of Roswell, will be held at 8:15 am., Friday, February 20, 2009 at St. Peter's Catholic Church. Richard passed away peacefully on Jan. 18, 2009 at Eastern New Mexico Medical Center. Memorial services were held at St. Edwards Parish in Salem, Oregon on Jan. 29th 2009 with burial at St. Barbara's Cemetery.

Richard was born Oct. 17, 1928 in Lowville, NY to James M. and May Welch McGrath. After serving in the Army from 1946 to 1948 in Korea and Japan, he graduated with a degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Dayton in Dayton, Ohio in 1952.
