Robert Melvin Miller, a long-time Roswell resident, passed away January 26, 2010, at the age of 79.

Robert was born in Roswell on January 26, 1931 to Charles P. and Iris Miller. He served his country in the military as a US Navy Corpsman during the Korean War.

Robert was active in the Roswell community for many years as a sports official for youth football, basketball, and baseball. He also was a life-long member of the Elks, a member and former President of the Roswell Sertoma Club, and volunteered for several years as a New Mexico Mounted Patrol Officer assisting the New Mexico State Police Department. Robert is survived by his wife Jane and daughter Sandi in Roswell, and one son, Colonel Scot Miller and his family, wife Leslie and their two sons, Zane and Jake, currently stationed at Macdill Air Force Base, Florida. Robert is preceded in death by his parents, Charles P. and Iris Miller, and one brother, Charles M. Miller.
