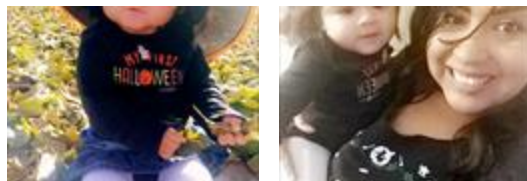
“ *Oh Mama!*

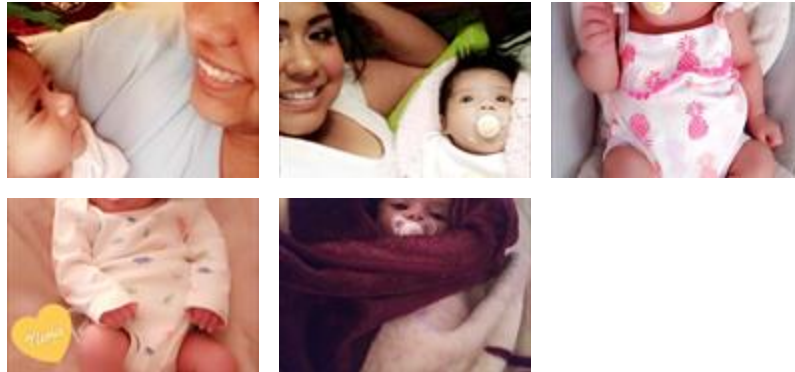
