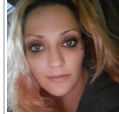

They would all say "he has us all laughing.." I always remember he told me that "he wanted to go home" I thought it was back to Roswell until I realized that home meant "Heaven." I will miss Sammy a lot but I know that the Heaven's gates have opened up for him and in the front to greet him is my Grandpa, Grandma, my Mother, his brother Raul and of course his aunts, uncles, nieces and nephews and friends.
