Sandra J. Mayfield Garcia, 68, of Roswell, New Mexico, gained her heavenly wings on April 27, 2026.

Sandy was born June 18, 1957, in Tucson, Arizona, to Elmer A. Mayfield and Elizabeth J. Nunez Shank. She was the second youngest of five daughters. As the child of a U.S. Air Force serviceman, she spent much of her early life traveling and living in various states and countries.

She eventually settled in Roswell, New Mexico, where she married and welcomed her first daughter, Sabrina, in 1978. 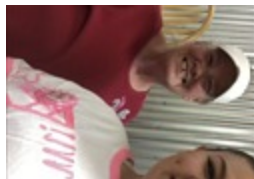

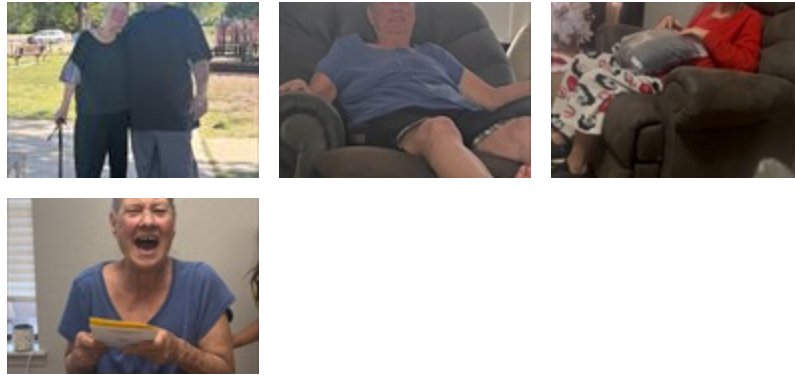

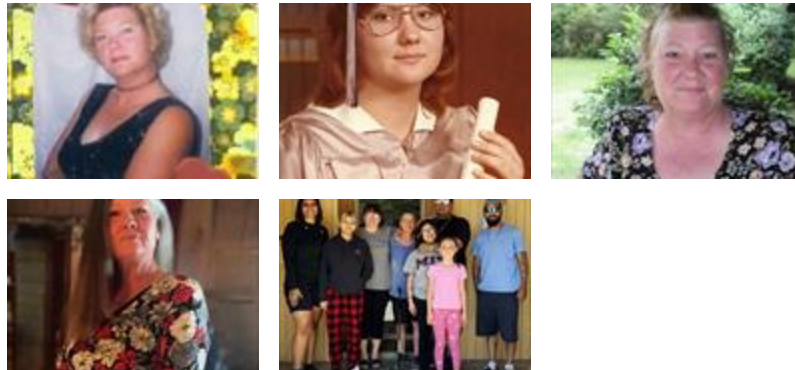
