Born into a farming family, Silvino joined the workforce at a young age and continued that unmatched work ethic until he retired many years later. Around the age of 14, Silvino moved to Delicias, Chihuahua, where he worked at an ice cream parlor. It was here that he met the love of his life, Maria Munoz, and on February 4, 1955, they married; after starting their family, they relocated to Cd. Juarez, Chihuahua, where Silvino would commute back and forth from the United States for work. Around 1990, Silvino, Maria, and their family relocated permanently to the United States, purchasing a home in Hagerman, New Mexico, and it was here that they planted their roots and have resided ever since. Up until his retirement, Silvino worked for Barney Green Farms, doing any and all jobs needed to make sure that farming operation was successful. After his

retirement, he spent his days surrounded with laughter and the love of his family; going on special road trips and making the best of the days he was given. One of Silvino's greatest achievements, and something he was incredibly proud of, was becoming a United States citizen on November 18, 2011.
