Theresa L. Hickman was born on February 24, 1963, to the late Robert Thomas Hickman, Jr. and Mary Elizabeth Hickman in Springfield, Massachusetts. She was gently lifted to Heaven's gates on Wednesday, November 6, 2019, surrounded by her family in Killeen, TX, gone too soon at the age of 56.

She received numerous certifications throughout her 30 plus years in the medical field. She mainly worked with the elderly, and she took pride in her job and the great care she gave her patients. She took a few years off from the medical field and Bartlett State Jail (Bartlett, TX), Chaves County Detention, Court Compliance Probation Officer and Roswell Job Corps Center. For many of her working years, she held down two jobs and sometimes three. In the end, she went

back to her love of taking care of the elderly. She literally worked until the day before she died even through all the treatments.

A loving mother, friend, and sister, Theresa was a remarkable cook and enjoyed preparing meals for her family and friends, most especially over the holidays. She loved her family very much. Theresa was the life of the party and could always be found smiling. Theresa loved dancing and singing to Whitney Houston, and would say, "don't I look like her?". She was an amazing homemaker, and she loved to decorate and clean. Theresa loved animals, her animals were as important (if not more) as her family. Even with all the animals that she has had over the years, you could never tell by the cleanliness of her house. Theresa enjoyed eating out, especially seafood, and Brother's pecan smoked ribs.

Theresa was a fighter who fought to live for her grandchildren. Her daughter lovingly cared for her in the last year of her life. The family gives her and everyone else who cared for her their greatest and warmest gratitude.

Preceding Theresa in death were her grandparents, mother, father, and nephew Robert Thomas Hickman, IV.

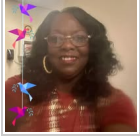
