On August 23, 1942, Thomas was born to Thomas and Annie McKinney of Summerville, SC. He attended Mooreville High School, Miss. where he graduated in 1960. He enlisted in the United States Air Force on January of 1961 and served until August of 1981, where he was honorably discharged from the military. During that time, he was serving his country, he fought in Vietnam and was awarded The National Defense Service Award and the Vietnam Service Award. His military assignments included; Vietnam, Walker AFB, NM., Kirtland AFB, NM., Bitburg AB, Germany., March AFB, CA., lastly Yokota AB, Japan in which he retired from military service in 1981. He also served for the State of New Mexico, Taxation and Revenue Department starting in Albuquerque, NM beginning in 1985 and running the State Taxation and Revenue Department in Roswell, NM, for Otero and Chavez counties, then retiring sometime in 2004. He married Dolores Olguin, who was the true love of his life. He loved to play golf at the local golf courses, especially Spring River golf course here in Roswell, NM. His favorite sports teams were the NFL Denver Broncos; Collegiate: Ole Miss. University, Miss. and Clemson University, South Carolina
