Timothy Andrew Boyd, 59, passed away on Monday, May 26, 2025, in Roswell, New Mexico.

The service will be held on Saturday, July 19, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. at Adventure Bible Church, located at 1905 South Main Street, Roswell, New Mexico.

On January 21, 1966, Tim was born to Joe and Karen Boyd in Walnut Creek, California. He attended Antioch High School. When Tim was just 18 years old, he met his future wife, Louise, and although he fibbed about his age, being 10 years younger, he knew she was the one. Together, they decided to move to Roswell, New Mexico, in 1984, and they were married on October 3, 1989, in Roswell. After arriving in Roswell, Tim worked at Buena Suerte Ranch for three years and then joined the TMC bus factory as a welder, staying with them through the transition to Nova Bus. He worked there for 10 years when it shut down, but that's also where he met some lifelong friends. After the closure, he opened his own business, Boyd's Welding, where he was known for his diverse welding abilities and was hired by many companies around Roswell for his exceptional welding technique and fabrication. He took pride in the work he did. Welding wasn't just a job; it was a hobby as well. He taught his wife to weld and anyone else who wanted to learn. Tim last worked at Mayes Lumber as the yard foreman for over 15 years, until COVID hit. He still took on side jobs for anyone who needed help. He always worked hard to

provide for his family. Tim was smart, creative, and very loyal to his friends, family, and his beliefs. One of his many hobbies was restoring old trucks, but his favorite project was building a race car for his wife, which he fabricated himself. It was a weekend pastime in the early 90s, and he made sure she was protected. Tim was an avid fisherman; he loved to take his family camping wherever there was water to fish in, and he could cook the best-tasting trout. He loved to pull pranks on people and have fun. His favorite holiday was the 4th of July; he loved to BBQ for everyone and risk his fingers to do all the fireworks. Tim wasn't much of a crowd person; he was the Walmart shopper at 3 a.m. to avoid the people, but he would endure it all to take his wife out dancing as often as he could.
