Unfortunately, it was

couple weeks later, also without studying. He was incredibly smart and quick witted.

TJ loved fiercely and was fiercely loyal to his family and friends. He was a kind soul who

was protective of children and defender of anyone being bullied.

He is remembered as being a dependable and hard worker growing up and

always

could be relied on to help when needed, especially on his grandparents' ranch.

As an adult, he preferred a nomadic lifestyle and loved being in nature where he felt

grounded, free and closer to Jesus. He was deeply spiritual and always kept a bible
