Veronica Bryan was born Veronica Rascon in Roswell, NM on September 22, 1976 to Jessie Hernandez of Roswell, NM. She was raised in Roswell and lived a short time in Ruidoso, NM and San Antonio, TX. Veronica went to high school in Roswell and later attended ENMU-Roswell.

Veronica gave birth to her son Dominic Larez on January 31, 1994 and later married Harley Bryan on December 8, 2000, giving birth to their son Jack Bryan on October 5, 2001. Both children survive her at the family home. Also surviving are her mother, Jessie Hernandez; grandmother, Carmen Carrillo; sister, Monica Rascon; brother, Juan Rascon and his wife Reina and nephew Rocco Rascon as well as numerous aunts, uncles and cousins. As a daughter, her mother remembers that not a day went by that Veronica didn't call her several times a day just to let her know she was thinking of her. She was a tender and affectionate mom whose greatest joy in life were her kiddos. There were many times there was no money available yet she always found a way for her and the kids to have fun together. She had a million watt smile and found time to build great memories with her kids. As a sister, her siblings think they couldn't have had a better one. Her brother remembers her working to help support the family at sixteen and giving him spending money as a young boy. "She'd cook me breakfast and dinner plus pack my lunch." Her sister remembers Veronica always encouraging her to be more outgoing and "to come out of her shell." Veronica had a nurturing nature and easygoing manner that just can't be replaced. Now it's up to us to do what we have to do in order to see YOU!

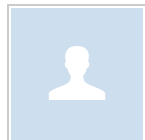

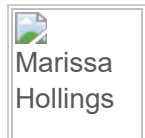
