Obituary for Rev. Walter Green Served the Lord in the Ministry for Sixty Years
Funeral services for Rev. Walter Green Jr., 83, of Roswell will be held at 1 pm Wednesday, April 4, 2007, at Anderson-Bethany Funeral Home with Rev. Joe Lewis of Mt. Zion Baptist Church officiating. Burial will follow in South Park Cemetery. Rev. Green went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ Sunday, March 25, 2007.

The viewing for Rev. Green will be from 1 to 7 pm Sunday, 8am to 7 pm Monday and Tuesday, and from 8 am to service time Wednesday.

Rev. Green, the fourth of five children, was born on November 8, 1923 to Walter Green Sr. and Trudy Robinson Green in Mount Pleasant, Texas. He was a veteran of World War II serving with the United States Army. Rev. Green moved to Roswell in 1977 and was the pastor of Galilee Baptist Church of over thirty years. He loved to go fishing; he always said it made him feel closer to God, and to share his faith with everyone.
