Over the years, he raised and cared for many birds, large and small, and could often be found sitting quietly in a coop, surrounded by them, thoughtfully contemplating life. He also loved football, and was a devoted Dallas Cowboys fan, standing by his team through every high and low.

Walter's professional life spanned many industries. In his younger years, and again prior to retirement, he worked in the oil fields of New Mexico and West Texas. One of his proudest accomplishments was owning and operating Woodrome Construction during the 90s and early 2000s. Specializing in tile

work, Walter took great pride in his craftsmanship and was known for his perfectionism and attention to detail.

Walter was a husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and lifelong friend to many in the Roswell community. He will be deeply and sorely missed.

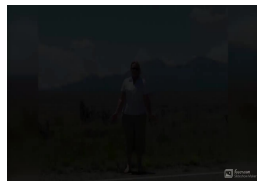
