Preceding Wendy in death were her son, Timothy Allen Artiaga; and parents: Robert Ethen Merryfield and Joan Lucy Merryfield.

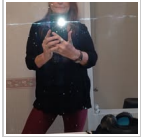

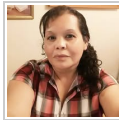
