Whom we will never see.

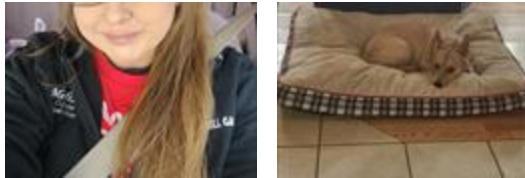
But we will see him again,
