William "Bill" Calvin Atkinson passed away Sunday, September 16, 2012, in his home in Roswell, NM. He was 73 years old. Bill was born in Weed, CA, to George Atkinson and Dorothy Cash. He was the youngest of two children. After High School he served in the United States Navy, where he earned an honorable Discharge. He met the love of his life while working in Alhambra, CA. He asked her to marry him in 1961. In 1972 he moved his family to Roswell, NM where he made a home.

He began his professional career as a banker, in Alhambra, CA before working at the Farmers Insurance Agency until retiring many years later. He began as an adjustor, and climbed the ladder to become District Manager before relinquishing the role to build his own agency and spend more time at home. His joy other than friends and family included traveling and attending grandkids sporting events. He was a Life member of the Roswell Elks where he served as Exalted Ruler, District Deputy and District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler. He loved his Elk Brothers and Sisters.
